

DANIEL M. METCALF SCHOLARSHIP Cover Sheet

The Daniel M. Metcalf scholarship program was established by the Vilas Alumni Association in 1958. Many fundraising events took place over the years to establish future financial stability. Daniel M. Metcalf was Principal of the 'Vilas High School' for over twenty years. After Mr. Metcalf's death in 1992, the scholarship became the Daniel M. Metcalf Scholarship Fund in his honor. As a former teacher commented, "Daniel M. Metcalf's only ambition was to serve the community, preparing each student to attain their highest potential."

Two (2) Daniel M. Metcalf Scholarships are awarded annually to students who completed at least one full year in the eighth grade at Vilas Middle School and has successfully completed one or more years of continuing higher education beyond high school and currently enrolled in a Vocational/Technical Trade School, Junior College, College or University, or a Graduate Program.

The scholarship is supported through the "Vilas Alumni Trust Fund".

Applications for the Daniel M. Metcalf Scholarship will be judged on the following criteria: Highest scores on overall scholastic achievement, personal essay on describing your educational and career objectives, your strengths, extra-curricular/leadership recognitions and any work experience.

The Vilas Middle School Scholarship Committee is comprised six (6) members. The Vilas Middle School principal, FMRHS Guidance Counselor, Vilas Middle School Teacher, FMSD School Board member and two Vilas High School Alumni.

All application materials are considered CONFIDENTIAL and will be limited to examination for their intended purpose only.
